Dr Bohaira is a Fellow of the RCOG and FSRH in London. She was awarded a Doctorate of Medicine from the University of Southampton on

“Studies in Women's Reproductive Healthcare”. Dr. Bohaira's research has been widely published in peer-reviewed journals. In Dubai, she has organised more than six international conferences, workshops, and educational events focusing on fertility and women's health and established three IVF clinics in Dubai. Professor Chapron's research activities focus on the pathogenesis, assessment, and management of endometriosis, as well as gynecologic operative laparoscopy. He has authored and co-authored 474 peer-reviewed papers in international (347 publications) and in national (127 publications) scientific journals on surgical laparoscopy in gynecology, reproductive medicine, endometriosis and adenomyosis. Publications were cited more than 36 004 times and his H-factor is 97 (indice i10 is 343). Professor Chapron has performed over 1 000 scientific presentations in international (743) and in national (333) meetings. He is the coordinator of 14 scientific books and the author of more than 80 chapters in other scientific books.



**Prof. Dr. Engin Oral, Turkey**

MD is a renowned Turkish Reproductive Endocrinologist and Gynecologic surgeon with expertise in endometriosis, infertility, ART, menopause, and minimally invasive surgery. He earned his medical degree from Istanbul University Faculty of Medicine and completed his OB/GYN residency at Istanbul Medical Faculty. He later completed a postdoctoral research fellowship at Yale University in Reproductive Endocrinology under the mentorship of Prof. Aydin Arici and Prof. David Olive.

Prof. Oral served as faculty at Istanbul University Cerrahpaşa (1993–2019), was Professor of OB/GYN at Bezmialem Vakif University (2020–2022), and currently holds a professorship at Biruni University. He is also an Affiliated as professor at Department of Clinical Sciences in Obstetrics and Gynecology at the Umeå University, Sweden. He has authored over 83 peer-reviewed articles and contributed to major clinical guidelines, including the Turkish and ESHRE Endometriosis Guidelines. He is the editor of *Endometriosis and Adenomyosis: Global Perspectives Across the Lifespan* (Springer, 2022). He is the Founding Current Chair of the Endometriosis and Adenomyosis Society of Türkiye, Past President of the European Endometriosis League, and currently serves as Executive Board Member of the World Endometriosis Society (WES) and Vice Chair of the ASRM Endometriosis Special Interest Group (EndoSIG).

A key figure in education and advocacy, Prof. Oral organizes international conferences, workshops, and awareness campaigns, including activities for World Endometriosis Day. His leadership and research continue to shape the field of reproductive medicine both nationally and internationally.



**Professor Eric Jauniaux, MD, PhD, FRCOG**

Professor in Obstetrics and Fetal Medicine, EGA Institute for Women Health, Faculty of Population Health Science, University College London, London, UK.

I have worked for over 30 years on placental and fetal development and on the diagnosis and management of placental-related complications of pregnancy.

I am the author/co-author of over 500 peer-reviewed original articles and has edited/co-edited 14 books, including Embryonic medicine & therapy with Sir Bob Edwards (Nobel Prize in Medicine 2010).

I am currently working on the ultrasound imaging, pathophysiology of accreta placentation, and the impact of the environment on human pregnancy. I am currently the lead developer for the 2026 RCOG GTG27 (A: placenta praevia, placenta accreta, and B: vasa praevia).




